1/2/2011	1/8–9/2011	Deuteronomy 7:9	Know therefore that the LORD your God is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments, to a thousand generations.
1/9/2011	1/15–16/2011	Deuteronomy 10:12–13	And now , Israel, what does the LORD your God require of you, but to fear the LORD your God, to walk in all his ways, to love him, to serve the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul, and to keep the commandments and statutes of the LORD, which I am commanding you today for your good?
1/16/2011	1/22–23/2011	John 1:12–13	But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God, who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.
1/23/2011	1/29–30/2011	Romans 11:33–36	Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments and how inscrutable his ways! “For who has known the mind of the Lord, or who has been his counselor?” “Or who has given a gift to him that he might be repaid?” For from him and through him and to him are all things. To him be glory forever. Amen.
1/30/2011	2/5–6/2011	Romans 12:1–2	I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.
2/6/2011	2/12–13/2011	Psalms 56:3–4	When I am afraid, I put my trust in you. In God, whose word I praise, in God I trust; I shall not be afraid. What can flesh do to me?
2/13/2011	2/19–20/2011	Psalms 62:5–7 [8]	For God alone, O my soul, wait in silence, for my hope is from him. He only is my rock and my salvation, my fortress; I shall not be shaken. On God rests my salvation and my glory; my mighty rock, my refuge is God. [Trust in him at all times, O people; pour out your heart before him; God is a refuge for us.]
2/20/2011	2/26–27/2011	Romans 8:1	There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.
2/27/2011	3/5–6/2011	1 John 2:15–17	Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world—the desires of the flesh and the desires of the eyes and pride in possessions—is not from the Father but is from the world. And the world is passing away along with its desires, but whoever does the will of God abides forever.
3/6/2011	3/12–13/2011	Philippians 2:5–7	Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but made himself nothing, taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men.
3/13/2011	3/19–20/2011	Philippians 2:8–9	And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name,
3/20/2011	3/26–27/2011	Philippians 2:10–11	...so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord to the glory of God the Father.

3/27/2011	4/2-3/2011	Philippians 2:12-13	Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, so now, not only as in my presence but much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling, for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure.
4/3/2011	4/9-10/2011	James 1:2-3	Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness.
4/10/2011	4/16-17/2011	James 1:4-5	And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing. If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him.
4/17/2011	4/23-24/2011	Psalms 1:1-2	Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers; but his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on his law he meditates day and night.
4/24/2011	4/30-5/1/2011	Psalms 1:3-4	He is like a tree planted by streams of water that yields its fruit in its season, and its leaf does not wither. In all that he does, he prospers. The wicked are not so, but are like chaff that the wind drives away.
5/1/2011	5/7-8/2011	Psalms 1:5-6	Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous; for the LORD knows the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish.
5/8/2011	5/14-15/2011	Colossians 3:1-3	If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth. For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God.
5/15/2011	5/21-22/2011	Ephesians 4:26	Be angry and do not sin; do not let the sun go down on your anger.
5/22/2011	5/28-29/2011	Isaiah 40:28-29	Have you not known? Have you not heard? The LORD is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He does not faint or grow weary; his understanding is unsearchable. He gives power to the faint, and to him who has no might he increases strength.
5/29/2011	6/4-5/2011	Isaiah 40:30-31	Even youths shall faint and be weary, and young men shall fall exhausted; but they who wait for the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint.
6/5/2011	6/11-12/2011	Psalms 86:5-7	For you, O Lord, are good and forgiving, abounding in steadfast love to all who call upon you. Give ear, O LORD, to my prayer; listen to my plea for grace. In the day of my trouble I call upon you, for you answer me.
6/12/2011	6/18-19/2011	1 Timothy 2:5	For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus...
6/19/2011	6/25-26/2011	1 Peter 1:3-5	Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you, who by God's power are being guarded through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.
6/26/2011	7/2-3/2011	Ephesians 6:10-11	Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil.

7/3/2011	7/9–10/2011	Ephesians 6:12–13	For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places. Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm.
7/10/2011	7/16–17/2011	Ephesians 6:14–15	Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and, as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace.
7/17/2011	7/23–24/2011	Ephesians 6:16–17 [18]	In all circumstances take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one; and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, [praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints.]
7/24/2011	7/30–31/2011	Philippians 1:6	...I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ.
7/31/2011	8/6–7/2011	Matthew 10:28	And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather fear him who can destroy both soul and body in hell.
8/7/2011	8/13–14/2011	Romans 1:16 [17]	For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. [For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith for faith, as it is written, “The righteous shall live by faith.”]
8/14/2011	8/20–21/2011	Matthew 11:28–30	Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.
8/21/2011	8/27–28/2011	Psalms 20:6–7 [8]	Now I know that the LORD saves his anointed; he will answer him from his holy heaven with the saving might of his right hand. Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the LORD our God. [They collapse and fall, but we rise and stand upright.]
8/28/2011	9/3–4/2011	James 1:12	Blessed is the man who remains steadfast under trial, for when he has stood the test he will receive the crown of life, which God has promised to those who love him.
9/4/2011	9/10–11/2011	2 Corinthians 9:6–7	The point is this: whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. Each one must give as he has made up his mind, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.
9/11/2011	9/17–18/2011	2 Corinthians 9:8	And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that having all sufficiency in all things at all times, you may abound in every good work.
9/18/2011	9/24–25/2011	2 Corinthians 12:9 [10]	...“My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me. [For the sake of Christ, then, I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and calamities. For when I am weak, then I am strong.]
9/25/2011	10/1–2/2011	Isaiah 64:4	From of old no one has heard or perceived by the ear; no eye has seen a God besides you, who acts for those who wait for him.

10/2/2011	10/8–9/2011	Titus 3:4–6	But when the goodness and loving kindness of God our Savior appeared, he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior.
10/9/2011	10/15–16/2011	Isaiah 46:9–10 [11]	...I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me, declaring the end from the beginning and from ancient times things not yet done, saying, 'My counsel shall stand, and I will accomplish all my purpose,' [calling a bird of prey from the east, the man of my counsel from a far country. I have spoken, and I will bring it to pass; I have purposed, and I will do it.]
10/16/2011	10/22–23/2011	Proverbs 1:10	My son, if sinners entice you, do not consent.
10/23/2011	10/29–30/2011	Proverbs 3:5–6 [7]	Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths. [Be not wise in your own eyes; fear the LORD, and turn away from evil.]
10/30/2011	11/5–6/2011	Proverbs 19:11	Good sense makes one slow to anger and it is his glory to overlook an offense.
11/6/2011	11/12–13/2011	John 15:5	I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing.
11/13/2011	11/19–20/2011	John 14:2–3	In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also.
11/20/2011	11/26–27/2011	Psalms 125:1–2	Those who trust in the LORD are like Mount Zion, which cannot be moved, but abides forever. As the mountains surround Jerusalem, so the LORD surrounds his people, from this time forth and forevermore.
11/27/2011	12/3–4/2011	Psalms 141:3–4	Set a guard, O LORD, over my mouth; keep watch over the door of my lips! Do not let my heart incline to any evil.
12/4/2011	12/10–11/2011	1 John 1:8–9	If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
12/11/2011	12/17–18/2011	Psalms 23:1–2	The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters.
12/18/2011	12/24–25/2011	Psalms 23:3–4	He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake. Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.
