

Acts 13–28

Jesus' Witnesses, Empowered by His Spirit

In the Book of Acts, Jesus promised his disciples that they would take the gospel to the remotest parts of the earth. We'll observe Paul's transformation from persecutor of the church to preacher and his journeys across the Roman world to proclaim the saving message of Jesus to Jews and Gentiles. Come learn how to witness and how to live an authentic Christian life in all circumstances in the power of the Holy Spirit. Learn to be bold in proclaiming the name of Jesus and to trust our sovereign Lord who enables us to endure persecution and suffering at the hands of those who hate Jesus...and therefore, hate us.

1 Kings, 2 Chronicles A Divided Heart / A Divided Nation

What happens when your heart is divided? What lessons can we learn for our lives today from the examples of Solomon, Rehoboam, Jeroboam, and Abijam? What does God do when his people trust their own judgment and disobey him?

Romans 12–16 Life as a Living Sacrifice

The righteous shall live by faith! Do you live out your faith? What practical things can you do to show that you have been justified? Romans 12–16 are very practical chapters! You will learn how redemption, justification, and propitiation enable you to live righteously as you serve God.

2 Peter How to Be Kept From Falling

This Bible study is for men, women, and couples. When the Apostle Peter wrote this epistle, he knew he would die soon. In this ten-week study, you will learn how to discover Peter's final passions and their profound implications. Each week will consist of a group discussion, live lecture, and small group prayer.

Beloved Disciple
